3rd Academic Term Schedule Changes by November 23rd

Monday, November 23rd schedule change deadline. This is the deadline for all schedule changes to be requested for 3rd Academic Term classes. Students having full schedules when we begin on December 1st will greatly enhance a smooth transition.

Last Day of the 2nd Academic Term November 24th

The second academic term will end at the end of the day on Tuesday, November 24th as we head into Thanksgiving break.
